#### A. **General Intelligence & Reasoning:**

It would include questions of both verbal and non-verbal type. The test will include questions on analogies, similarities and differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, visual memory, discriminating observation, relationship concepts, arithmetical reasoning, verbal and figure classification, arithmetical number series, non-verbal series etc. The test will also include questions designed to test the candidate's abilities to deal with abstract ideas and symbols and their relationship, arithmetical computation and other analytical functions.

#### B. **General Awareness:**

Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidate's general awareness of the environment around him and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observation and experience in their scientific aspects as may be expected of an educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its Neighboring countries especially pertaining to Sports, History, Culture, Geography, Economic scene, General Policy including Indian Constitution, and Scientific Research, Computer, RTI etc.

**C. Numerical Aptitude:**

Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidate's in Numerical aptitude based on Data Interpretation, Profit & Loss, Simple Interest, HCF & LCM, Time and Work, Time and Distance, Simplification, Algebra, Percentage, Number System, Decimal Fractions, Compound Interest, permutation combination and probability etc.

**D. English Language & Comprehension:**

In addition to the testing of candidates' understanding of the English Language, its vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure, synonyms, antonyms and its correct usage, etc. his/ her writing ability, would also be tested.

**E. Communication:**

Question will be based on method of Communication, means of communication, process, barriers and communication skills

**F. Subject/ Trade knowledge:**

**1. Social Work Instructor**

Question will be based on Sociology concepts, Social theories, Government schemes, community organization, field visits, family welfare, NGO, guidance and counseling etc.

**2. Store Keeper**

Question will be based on general Financial Rules and Regulations, Procurement of goods and Items, Tendering system, Maintenance of stock books and registers and GEM etc.

**3. Lady Health Visitor**

Question will be based on Basic Nursing knowledge, RMNCH+A, Clinical services, Immunization, Nursing procedures etc.

**4. Hindi Translator**

Question will be based on translation skills in Hindi and English, Vocabulary, precise and drafting and official language act etc.
